NAVSUP Publication P-724 prescribes policies and procedures for Navy and Marine Corps conventional ordnance distribution and stockpile management. NAVSUP P-724 is applicable to all Navy/Marine Corps activities and personnel involved in the management of Department of the Navy explosive ordnance material with supply cognizance 2D, 2E, 2T, 4T, 6T, 8E, 8T, and 8U, under the cognizance of Navy and Marine Corps Acquisition/Program Managers. NAVSUP Pub 724 additionally describes ammunition reporting, accounting and management practices for Marine Corps OT Cog assets stored at Navy activities and ships. Publication of the basic publication represented the consolidation of several Navy ordnance policies and procedures. Revision 8 provides updates in many areas and incorporates the following changes:

- Added a standard statement to the CDRL regarding Contractor asset reporting in Chapter 2 Section 1.
- Clarified the Amplification of Source Codes in Chapter 2 Section 3
- Updated Chapter 5 Section 6 to current DEMIL operating procedures.
- Clarified the policy concerning MLSR and OPREP- 3 Navy Blue in Chapter 6 Section 2.
- Updated the Cataloging/Identification/Disposition Request Form and Cataloging procedures in Chapter 8.
- NAVAMMOLOGCEN forms were changed to reflect NOLSC-AMMO.

Until otherwise notified, the message PLAD for Naval Operational Logistics Support Center-Ammo will remain NAVAMMOLOGCEN MECHANICSBURG PA. The PLAD for Naval Operational Logistics Support Center Ammunition Management Office, Norfolk VA will remain NAVAMMOLOGCEN AMMOLANT NORFOLK VA.
